


Sample Name: Poly (t-butyl acrylate)

Synthesis Procedure:

Poly(t-butyl acrylate) is obtained by anionic polymerization process.

Characterization:

The molecular weight and polydispersity index (PDI) are obtained by size exclusion chromatography (SEC) in THF. SEC analysis was performed on a Varian liquid chromatograph equipped with refractive and UV light scattering detectors. Three SEC columns from Supelco (G6000-4000-2000 HXL) were used with triple detectors from Viscotek Co.


Solubility:

Poly(t-butyl acrylate) is soluble in THF, DMF and CHCl₃.

SEC elugram of Sample:


